14/09/2022 – Hindi Diwas @ KLP

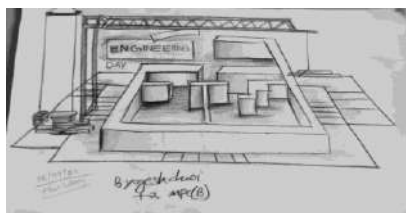

On this great occasion our Hindi department worked a lot and did a fabulous work. On this great day “**Daksha**” award was presented to Veronika of Class X.



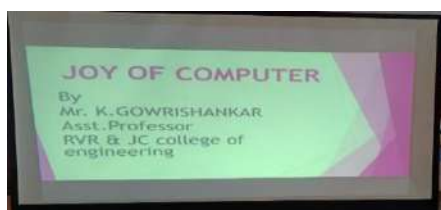
15/09/2022 – National Engineer’s Day
